I. PROJECT BACKGROUND

SFL is implementing the Linking Infrastructure, Finance, and Farms to Cashew (LIFFT-Cashew), an eight-year United States Department of Agriculture (USDA)-funded Food for Progress Program (FFPr) in Senegal, The Gambia, and Guinea-Bissau. The LIFFT program initially planned from 2017 to 2023 was granted a merit-based extension with a revised end date of December 30, 2025. The program is addressing multiple aspects of the Cashew Value Chain by upgrading existing linkages and building new ones to create a more integrated and durable regional network to enhance cashew production, the processing and selling of quality cashew products. This project aims to strengthen the competitiveness of the cashew value chain by facilitating access to high value-added local and international markets.

The aim of this call is to recruit a qualified certification body to support cashew cooperatives and processors in the certification process according to organic (CE848/18 and NOP) and HACCP standards.

II. PURPOSE OF THE INVITATION TO TENDER

The objective of this invitation to tender is to engage an accredited certification body to audit and certify cashew processors and cooperatives in accordance with organic (CE848/18 and NOP) and HACCP standards and issue the relevant certificates.

III. DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK

The selected organization will be responsible for:

- Audit and certify cashew producers/cooperative to CE848/18 and NOP standards.
- Audit and certify processing facilities/companies and processes according to HACCP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point) principles.
- Provide recommendations to cooperatives and processors to comply with current standards.

IV. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- Has accreditation for Audit and provision of organic certification in accordance with CE848/18 (EU) and NOP (USA) standards.
- Accreditation from the certifying agencies for HACCP Audit and certification.
- Proof of certification for similar projects in Africa or other regions.

- Presentation of the organization, including accreditations, certifications and relevant experience.
- Details of methodologies and tools used for NOP and HACCP certification.
- Proposed schedule for carrying out audits.
- Financial offer including detailed costs per activity.
- 03 references for similar projects.
- Copy of the document (accreditation) as proof that authorizes the consultant/company to do certification in accordance with HACCP, CE848/18 (EU) and NOP (USA) standards.
