<u>Title</u>: Purchase and delivery of: Moisture Meter, Electronic Scales, Scissor, Gloves and Trays

1. HISTORY OF SHELTER FOR LIFE

SFL is an international non-governmental organization, with its headquarters in Minnetonka, Minnesota, United States of America, and has been working in developing countries around the world since 1979. SFL works in more than fifteen countries around the world, guided by its philosophy of "restoring life by rebuilding communities". SFL provides emergency and development assistance in case of disaster or conflict, undertakes infrastructure reconstruction activities after such events, and provides micro finance products to support economic growth. SFL has helped millions of people by building or rehabilitating infrastructure as varied as temporary shelters, production roads, irrigation systems, schools, market infrastructure, etc. The NGO has also provided significant funding through thousands of micro-loans to help ease access to finance urgent needed funds to grow smallholders' production and business activities.

2. CONTEXT

Under the USDA/FAS Food For Progress (FFPr) program, Shelter For Life (SFL) is implementing a eight-year (2017-2025) project called "Linking Infrastructure, Finance and Farms to Cashew" (LIFFT-Cashew) in Senegal, Gambia and Guinea-Bissau (SeGaBi) that aims to develop and upgrade the value chain linkages needed to support an integrated regional trade network for the cashew value chain. However, in order to make the value chain more attractive, competitive and develop an inclusive economy in SeGaBi, the LIFFT-Cashew project focuses on improving cashew production, processing and trade on local and international markets, in collaboration with other parts of the value chain. It is in this context that cooperative members were trained on the importance of knowing how to determine cashew nut quality using out-turn and moisture content calculations, in order to obtain a good price on the market. To this end, the LIFFT-Cashew project intends to support cooperatives in the SeGaBi region in equipping themselves to test cashew nut quality. Shelter For Life is therefore launching a call for tenders for the procurement of moisture meters, electronic scales, scissors, gloves and trays.

3. OVERALL OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this call for tender is to procure 24 moisture meters, 24 electronic scales, 24 scissors, 48 packets of gloves and 48 plastic trays for the cooperatives. The equipment specifications are as follows:
